(During Lockdown period due to COVID 19)




3. All the Club Members worked out on a photo collage to give away our gratitude to the medical staff and the administration staff for their efforts to contain the spread of the virus.

Winner: Arindam Kashyap Ray, Jalukbari, Guwahati




5. Club also started its Instagram, Twitterand Facebook Pages to increase and promote the goals of the club.
