About the Programme

It is proposed to conduct a two day North East Inter NIT Geotechnical Students meet to initiate a feeling of brotherhood among geotechnical students in all the eight National Institute of Technologies in the North East. NIT Silchar, the oldest in this group has taken this initiative to unite the other NITs with a hope that the union will provide a forum for sharing of ideas, presentation of research findings and discussion of professional issues relevant to the overall growth of this region. The other aim of the programme is to promote student activities in the field of geotechnical research. With an association of all the NITs the area of research will increase manifold and students will find a diversified area for choosing their research problems.

With this background the programme is divided into three parts :

- 1. Paper presentation
- 2. Poster presentation
- 3. Physical model construction.

To make the programme attractive and lively it is proposed to hold competition among the participants for all the three sub-programmes. It is also proposed that the sub-theme lectures will be delivered by the faculty of these NITs so that they can promote their research activities

Field engineers of this region will also be invited in the programme so that they are also exposed to the research activities being carried out in the NITs and share their knowledge on the field problems and solutions.

- 2. Ground improvement techniques
- 3. Shallow and deep foundations
